

U of Illinois at Chicago Summer 2009 PLTW STI Directions

PLTW STI CLASSROOMS

Your destination for the classrooms is **Science and Engineering Laboratory East (building #607 on map), 900 West Taylor Street Chicago, Illinois 60607**. Parking is located in the parking structure at Halsted and Taylor Streets, just east of the Science and Engineering Laboratory East. Entrances on Taylor Street (south) or off of Halsted (north) across from the Hull House.

NOTE: on first Sunday arrival date for STI, you may park in the Lot 4 short-term parking lot to the NW of the Taylor Street Parking garage, then cross Halsted and enter the NW corner of the SEL class building under the breezeway for Institute registration and laptop check-in. Then you can use parking pass to be distributed at registration at the Taylor Street and Maxwell Street garages for the duration of your STI stay.

PLTW STI RESIDENCE HALL

Your destination for the residence hall is **Thomas Beckham Hall (building # 663 on map), 1250 S. Halsted Street, Chicago, IL 60607**. Parking is located in the parking structure on Maxwell & Union Streets, one block south of Thomas Beckham Hall and one block east of Halsted. (Entrance on Maxwell or Union.) Note that there is a small circle drive on the northwest side behind the Hall's main entrance (accessed via Newberry Avenue off of Roosevelt Road) for short-term unloading parking, or you may use street meter parking on Halsted or the Maxwell parking garage 1.5 blocks away after you receive STI parking pass at Classroom SEL registration upon arrival. (See above.)

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO RESIDENCE HALLS

You will be staying at Thomas Beckham Hall located at 1250 S. Halsted. It is located in the heart of University Village on UIC's South Campus. The apartments are located about 1 block south of Roosevelt on the west side of Halsted. By Car

From the North — Take I-90/94E (here, the Kennedy Expressway). Exit at Roosevelt Road. Turn right (west) onto Roosevelt Road. Turn left (south) onto Halsted Street. Continue south on Halsted Street to 1250 S Halsted.

From the South — Take I-90/94W (here, the Dan Ryan Expressway). Exit at Roosevelt Road. Turn left (west) onto Roosevelt Road. Turn left (south) onto Halsted Street. Continue south on Halsted Street to 1250 S Halsted.

From the West — Take I-290E (the Eisenhower Expressway) to I-90/94E toward Indiana. Exit at Roosevelt Road. Turn right (west) onto Roosevelt Road. Turn left (south) onto Halsted Street. Continue south on Halsted Street to 1250 S Halsted.

From the East — Take Roosevelt Road west to Halsted Street. Turn left (south) onto Halsted Street. Continue south on Halsted Street to 1250 S Halsted.

By Public Transportation

- **CTA Bus** — The residence hall is accessible via two different CTA bus routes:
 - **Route 8** runs north and south on Halsted Street. Your stop will be Rochford and Halsted Street.
 - **Route 12** runs east and west on Roosevelt Road. Your stop will be Roosevelt Road and Halsted Street. Continue to walk south on Halsted Street to 1250 S Halsted.

- **CTA Train** — Within the city, take the CTA Blue Line train to the UIC - Halsted stop. Walk south on Halsted Street or catch the CTA bus, Route 8. The distance from the UIC - Halsted stop and the classroom is approximately 8 blocks.

- **Metra Train**— There are 12 Metra Rail lines that go to one of the following downtown stations:
 - Union Station

 - Randolph (Metra Electric) or
