Housing Checklist/What to Bring

The following items are supplied in each two- or four-bedroom apartment:

Bedding

- One blanket
- One pillow
- One pillowcase
- Sheets
- Towels
- Washcloth

Kitchen Supplies

- Electric stove
- Microwave oven
- Refrigerator
- Plates and cups
- Utensils
- Pots and pans

* You may want to wash your linens between week one and week two of the STI in the laundry facilities at Thomas Beckham Hall.

In order to ensure that your two-week stay is as pleasant as possible, participants **may** want to consider bringing the following items:

Equipment/Appliances

- Cable ready television/VCR
- Laptop (required)
- Alarm clock
- Extension cords
- Coaxial cable cord (for free cable television access)
- CAT 5 cable for Internet access in bedroom
- Small desk lamp for additional lighting

Bedding

- Extra blanket
- Extra pillow
- Extra towels

Kitchen Supplies

- Cleaning supplies (paper towels, dish detergent, spray cleaner, etc.)
- Food containers
- Plastic storage and garbage bags

Personal Items

- Two-week supply of clothing (shorts are acceptable; classrooms are air conditioned, sweater/sweatshirt may be needed)
- Comfortable shoes
- Toiletries
- Medications
- Soap/shampoo
- Medical kit
- Shower slippers

Laundry Items

- Laundry detergent
- Clothes hangers
- Laundry bag/basket
- Iron

Miscellaneous Items

- Emergency information (emergency contacts, insurance, etc.)
- Long distance calling card
- Digital camera
- Umbrella
